- Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation upto a maximum of five years.
- Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the School as per rules of the Society.

Selection Procedure

6. **Scrutiny of Application.** Upon receiving the application , the screening committee will scrutinize all applications on the basis of eligibility criteria. All qualified candidates will be intimated accordingly via school email for written test.
7. **Selection Process.** The first part of selection process is written test. This test is not required for candidates who have taught in other AF schools for a minimum period of two years in the same category. The details of written test are as follows:

8. **Teaching Aptitude Test(TAT)** This is the second part of the selection process. All candidates who have passed the Written Test will be called for a Teaching Aptitude Test of 130 marks.
9. **Interview.** Candidates who have qualified the Teaching Aptitude Test will be called for an interview of 100 marks, which will be the final stage of the selection process. The Selection Committee will focus on communication ability and the co-curricular skills of the candidates besides assessing the subject knowledge.
10. Final Merit List of candidates will be prepared based on the performance of the candidates in TAT and interview.
11. **Procedure for applying:** Interested candidates can apply in prescribed format only (available on school website) along with copies of all necessary documents/ testimonials. Last date for receiving application (in prescribed format along with, copies of relevant documents) will be 30 Jun 2026 Applications can be sent by SPEED POST or by e-mail to jobs@airforceschoolagra.edu.in.
